Find out, where in the world it lives, what it looks like, what it eats, how does it hunt and why it is in danger. This could be based on the layers of soil and rock found underground. It could be based on animals that are found underground. Or it could be based on underground transport.</p> 	<p><b>PE:</b>            Can you try 3 new physical activities? This could be walking or a team game etc.             Include a description of each in your home learning book, if you would like to include photographs you can.</p>
<p><b>History:</b>            Create a fact-file based on coal mining in the South Yorkshire area. You could find out where the local pits were and where there were large disasters.
